Employment Laws and Regulations

California State Disability Insurance Remains at 1% with an increase in the wage base to \$122,909 (up from \$118,371 in 2019)

Social Security Wage Base Increased to \$137,700 (up from \$132,900 in 2019)

401k Contribution Limit \$19,500 plus \$6,500 make-up for those 50 or older

IRA Contribution Limit \$6,000 plus \$1000 make-up for those 50 or older

<u>Sexual Harassment Prevention</u> <u>Training</u>

SB 1343 (later amended to extend deadline) requires all California employers with five or more employees to provide two hours of sexual harassment training to supervisory staff and one hour of such training to non-supervisory staff within six months of hire or promotion into a supervisory role, and every two years after that by no later than January 1, 2021.

<u>CalSavers and Retirement Plan</u> <u>Requirements</u>

 State law requires that California employers, who don't already offer an employer-sponsored retirement plan and who have five or more employees, Also, make sure that you and your teachers have a "rainy day" plan for those days that the weather requires us to stay inside for much of the day.

either sponsor a retirement plan or participate in CalSavers. The three-year phased roll-out will include staggered deadlines for registration based on employer size.

GINGERBREAD PLAY DOUGH RECIPE:

2 cups plain flour (all purpose)

1/2 cup salt

3 tablespoons any oil

2 tablespoons cream of tartar

1 cup of boiling water (added gradually)

1 tablespoon ground ginger

2 tablespoons ground cinnamon

5 drops of glycerine for extra shine

METHOD:

Mix all of the dry ingredients into a bowl. Add

the oil. Stir in the boiling water and allow to cool briefly. Knead it into a workable dough on a floured surface using your hands.

After a few minutes it should be soft and smooth and none should come off on your fingers. If it's still a little sticky then add more flour, one tablespoon at a time until it's just right!

Finally, add the glycerine for that extra smooth softness and shine.
